The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. **However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead.** If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

P ROFESSIONAL & STAFF SERVICES 2,950

Our fee for the basic services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to, staff to respond to initial request for service; arrangement of funeral; preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits; recording vital statistics; preparation and placement of obituary notice; and coordination with those providing other portions of the funeral as required. Also included in this charge are overhead expenses relative to our facilities such as professional licensing, legal and accounting fees, insurance, building and utility expenses, parking lot and ground maintenance, taxes, equipment, furnishings, inventory costs, record keeping, and secretarial and administrative expenses.

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

E MBALMING 585

Embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement, that does not require you pay for it, such as a direct cremation or immediate burial.

Other Preparation of Body (Dressing, Cosmetics, & Placement in casket) Washing/Disinfecting when No Embalming 385

If embalming is declined, the Wisconsin State Board of Health (State Statute HSS 136.04) requires a licensed embalmer to perform alternative sanitary care of the deceased. 415
This also includes sheltering of deceased, chemicals and materials required for washing and disinfection, use of preparation room and special professional equipment, OSHA required bio-hazardous safety equipment, protective garments, and infectious waste disposal (the above charge relates to any or all the above services).
